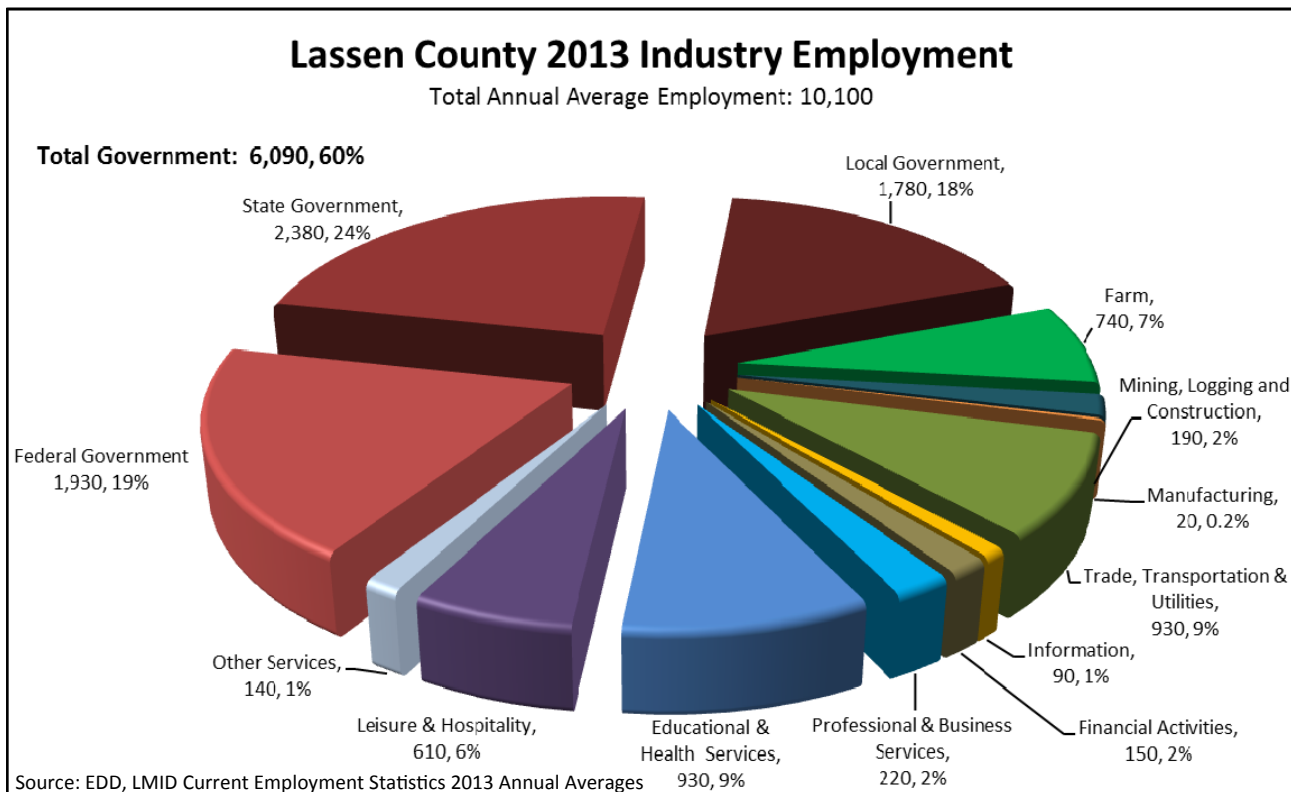

## Industry Employment

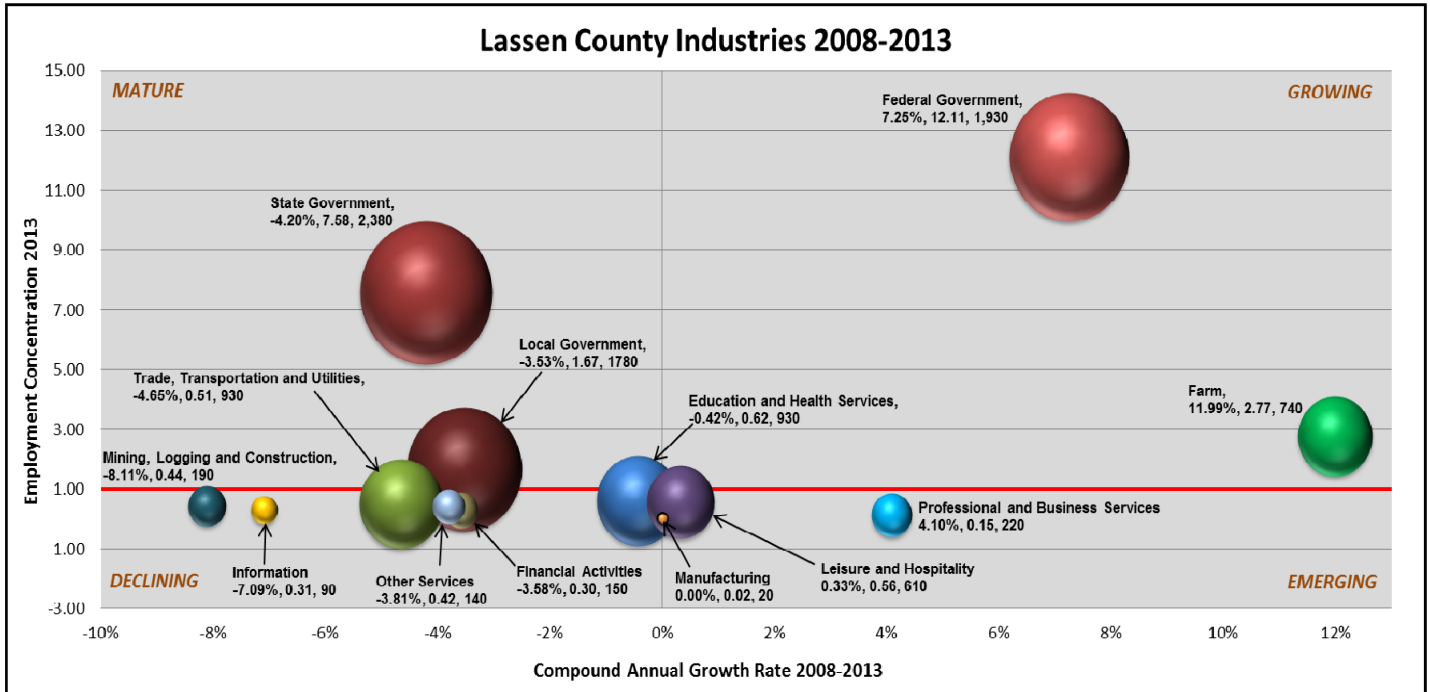


## Industry Highlights

- ▶ Lassen County's total annual average employment in 2013 was 10,100 jobs.
- ▶ Government was the largest industry, with 6,090 jobs of total employment. State Government made up the largest percentage of Government with 2,380 jobs.
- ▶ Trade, Transportation and Utilities, and Educational and Health Services each recorded 930 jobs, combining for 18 percent of total employment.
- ▶ Meanwhile, Leisure and Hospitality consisted of 6 percent of total employment with 610 jobs.

### Interpreting the chart:

- The size of the bubble indicates the employment size (number of jobs).
- The horizontal axis indicates the annual growth rate, or employment change, over the study period. Growth to the right on the graph is positive.
- The vertical axis indicates the concentration of an industry relative to the State. A concentration of 1.0 or higher indicates that the industry is more concentrated in the region than in the State.
- Industries in the right, upper quadrant show growth over the last five years and a higher concentration in the region compared to California.

## Industry Study Highlights

An employment concentration higher than 1.0 indicates a region's competitive advantage and an area of specialized economic activity compared to the State. Regional industries that showed an employment concentration of 1.25 or higher are considered heavily concentrated compared to California. In Lassen County, Federal Government led the industry sectors with a concentration level of 12.11, State Government was at 7.58, Farm was at 2.77, and Local Government was at 1.67.

Federal Government, and Farm are considered growth industries due to their significant employment concentrations and annual employment growth.

Professional and Business Services along with Manufacturing are considered emerging industries in Lassen County as they posted job growth or remained the same during the recession and have an employment concentration below 1.0.
