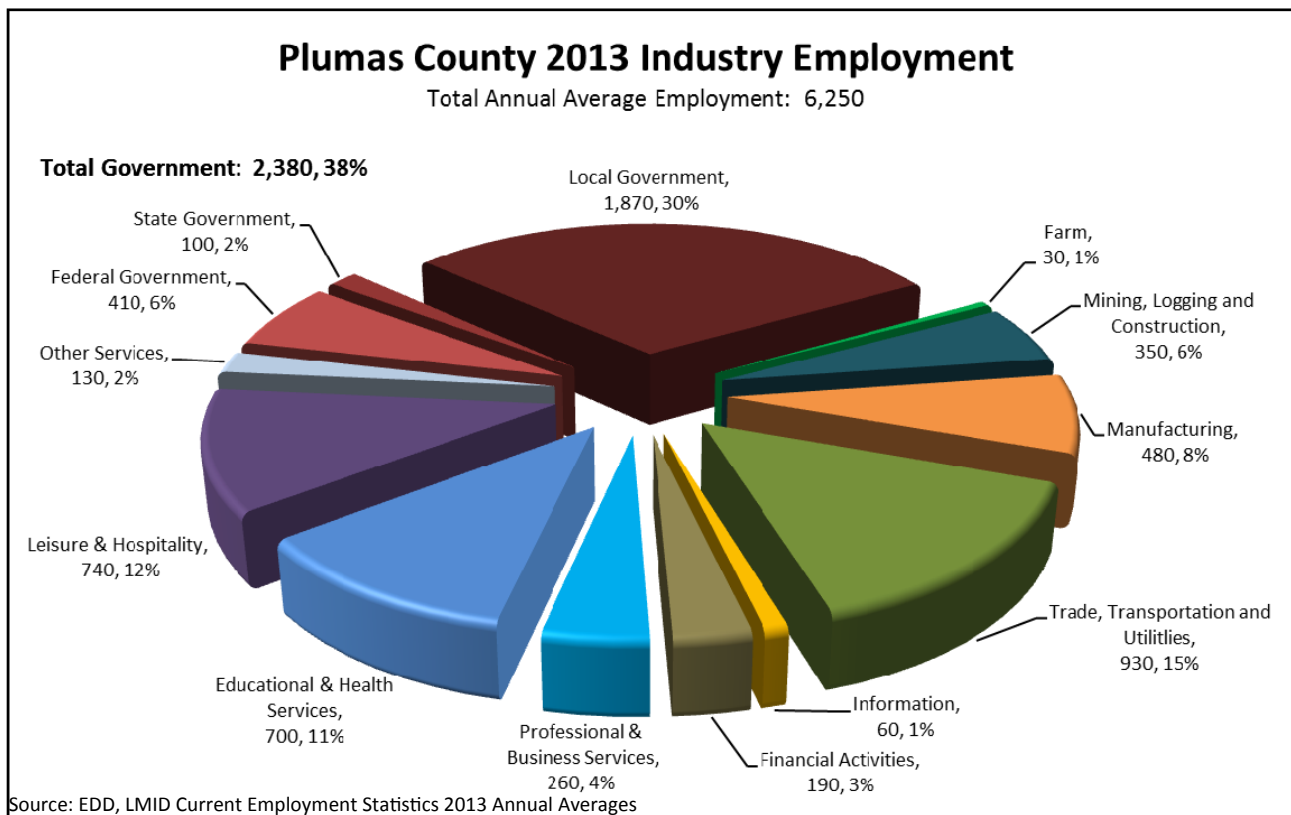

Industry Employment

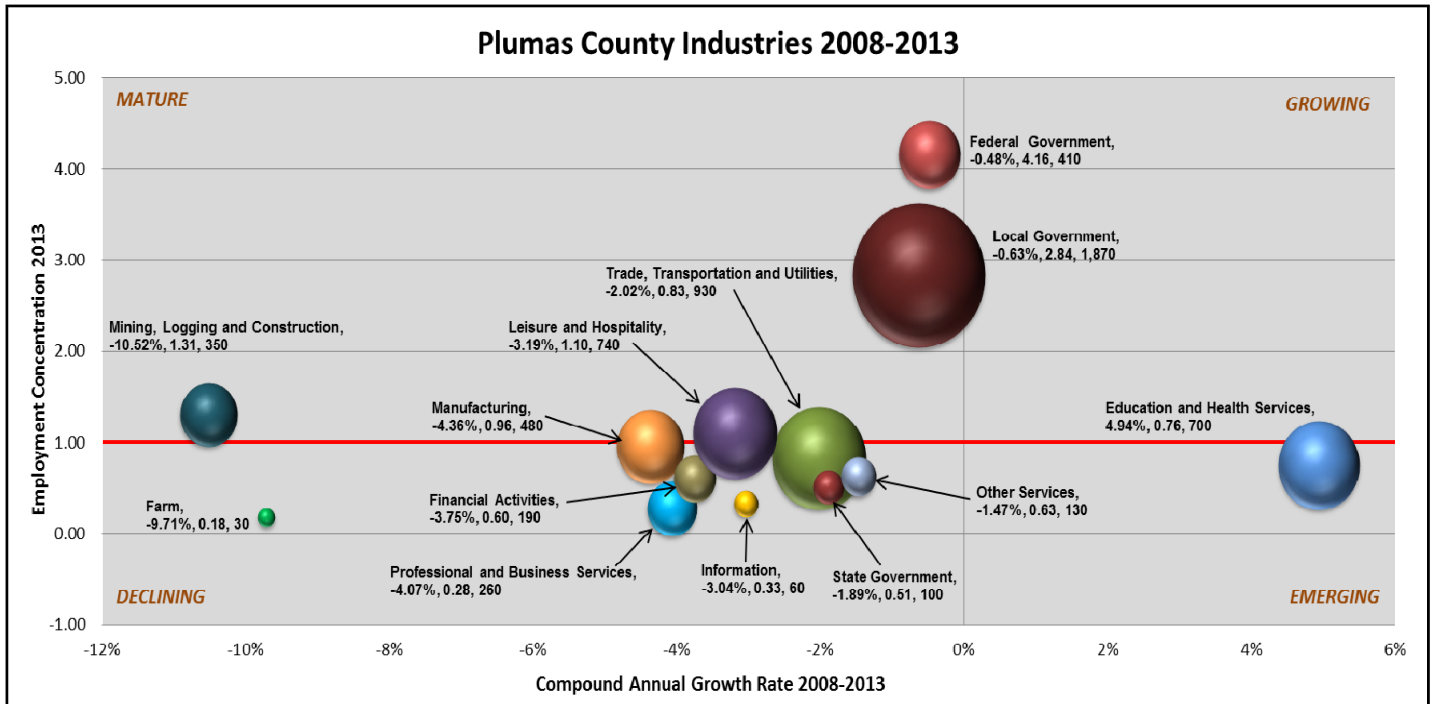


Industry Highlights

- ▶ Plumas County's total annual average employment in 2013 was 6,250 jobs.
- ▶ Government was the largest industry, recording 2,380 jobs, or 38 percent of total employment. Local Government made up the largest percentage of Government with 1,870 jobs.
- ▶ Trade, Transportation and Utilities was the second largest industry, with 930 jobs, consisting of 15 percent of total employment.
- ▶ Educational and Health Services recorded 700 jobs, or 11 percent of total employment. Meanwhile, Leisure and Hospitality reported 740 jobs, or 12 percent of total employment.

Interpreting the chart:

- The size of the bubble indicates the employment size (number of jobs).
- The horizontal axis indicates the annual growth rate, or employment change, over the study period. Growth to the right on the graph is positive.
- The vertical axis indicates the concentration of an industry relative to the State. A concentration of 1.0 or higher indicates that the industry is more concentrated in the region than in the State.
- Industries in the right, upper quadrant show growth over the last five years and a higher concentration in the region compared to California.

Industry Study Highlights

- ▶ An employment concentration higher than 1.0 indicates a region's competitive advantage and an area of specialized economic activity compared to the State. Regional industries that showed an employment concentration of 1.25 or higher are considered heavily concentrated compared to California. In Plumas County, Federal Government led the industry sectors with a concentration level of 4.16, Local Government was at 2.84, and Mining, Logging and Construction was at 1.31.
- ▶ Despite the declines in annual employment, Federal Government, Local Government, Mining, Logging and Construction, and Leisure and Hospitality were considered mature industries due to their employment concentrations above 1.0.
- ▶ Education and Health Services was below the employment concentration of 1.0; however, it was considered an emerging industry due to its significant employment growth.
