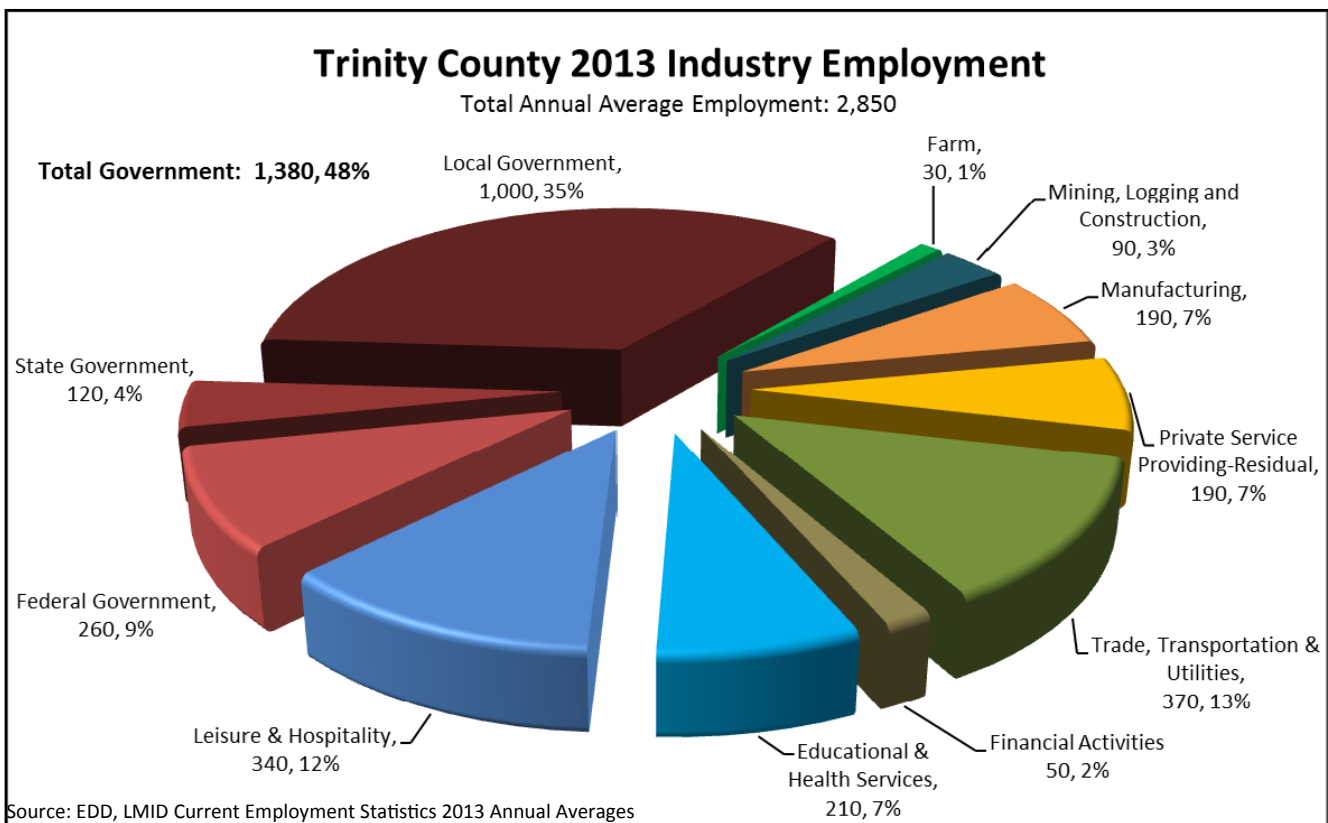

Industry Employment



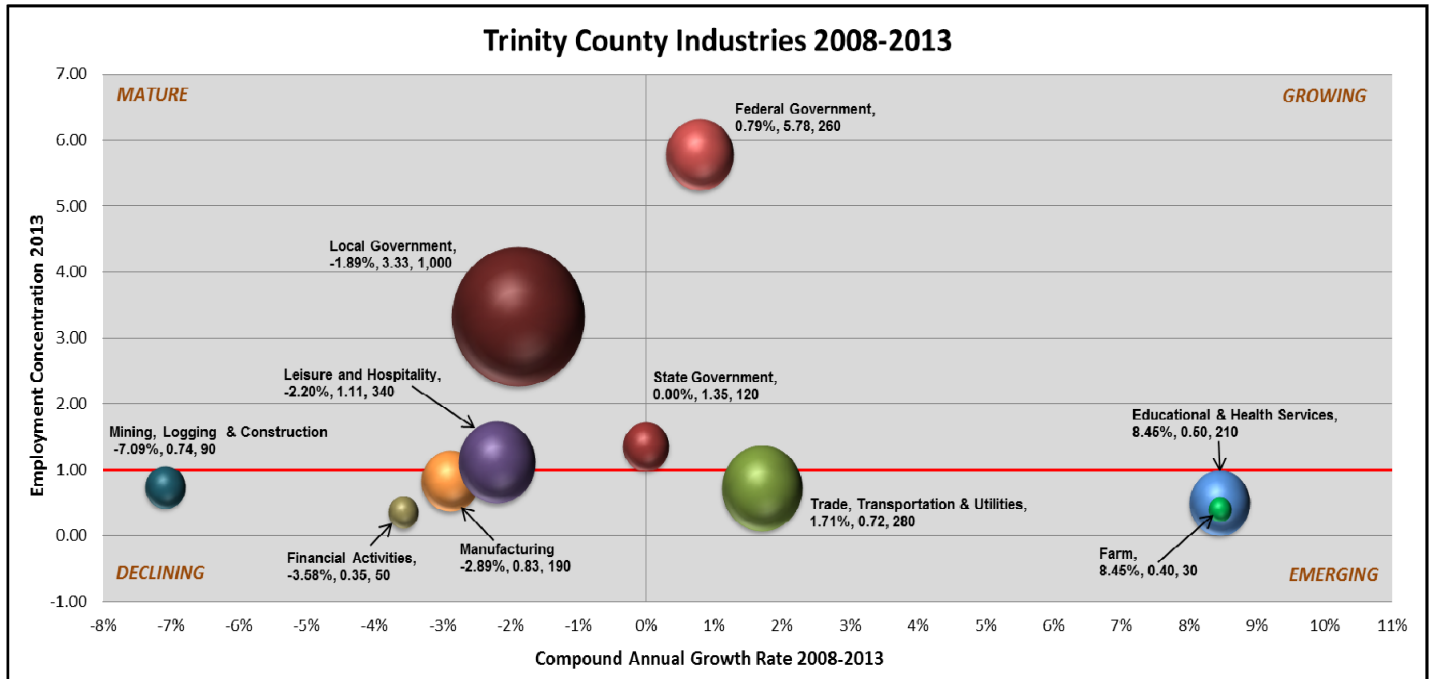
Industry Highlights

- ▶ Trinity County's total annual average employment in 2013 was 2,850 jobs.
- ▶ Government was the largest industry, with 1,380 jobs, comprising 48 percent of total employment. Local Government made up the largest portion of Government with 1,000 jobs.

- ▶ Trade, Transportation and Utilities was the second largest industry, accounting for 13 percent of total employment with 370 jobs.
- ▶ Leisure and Hospitality accounted for 12 percent of total employment with 340 jobs, and Educational and Health Services contributed 7 percent with 210 jobs.

Interpreting the chart:

- The size of the bubble indicates the employment size (number of jobs).
- The horizontal axis indicates the annual growth rate, or employment change, over the study period. Growth to the right on the graph is positive.
- The vertical axis indicates the concentration of an industry relative to the State. A concentration of 1.0 or higher indicates that the industry is more concentrated in the region than in the State.
- Industries in the right, upper quadrant show growth over the last five years and a higher concentration in the region compared to California.

Industry Study Highlights

- ▶ An employment concentration higher than 1.0 indicates a region's competitive advantage and an area of specialized economic activity compared to the State. Regional industries that showed an employment concentration of 1.25 or higher are considered heavily concentrated compared to California. In Trinity County, Federal Government led the industry studies with a concentration level of 5.78, Local Government was at 3.33, and State Government was at 1.35.
- ▶ Federal Government is considered a growth industry due to its significant employment concentration and annual job growth.
- ▶ Despite an employment concentration below 1.0, Trade, Transportation, and Utilities, Farm, and Educational and Health Services are all emerging industries due to job growth.
